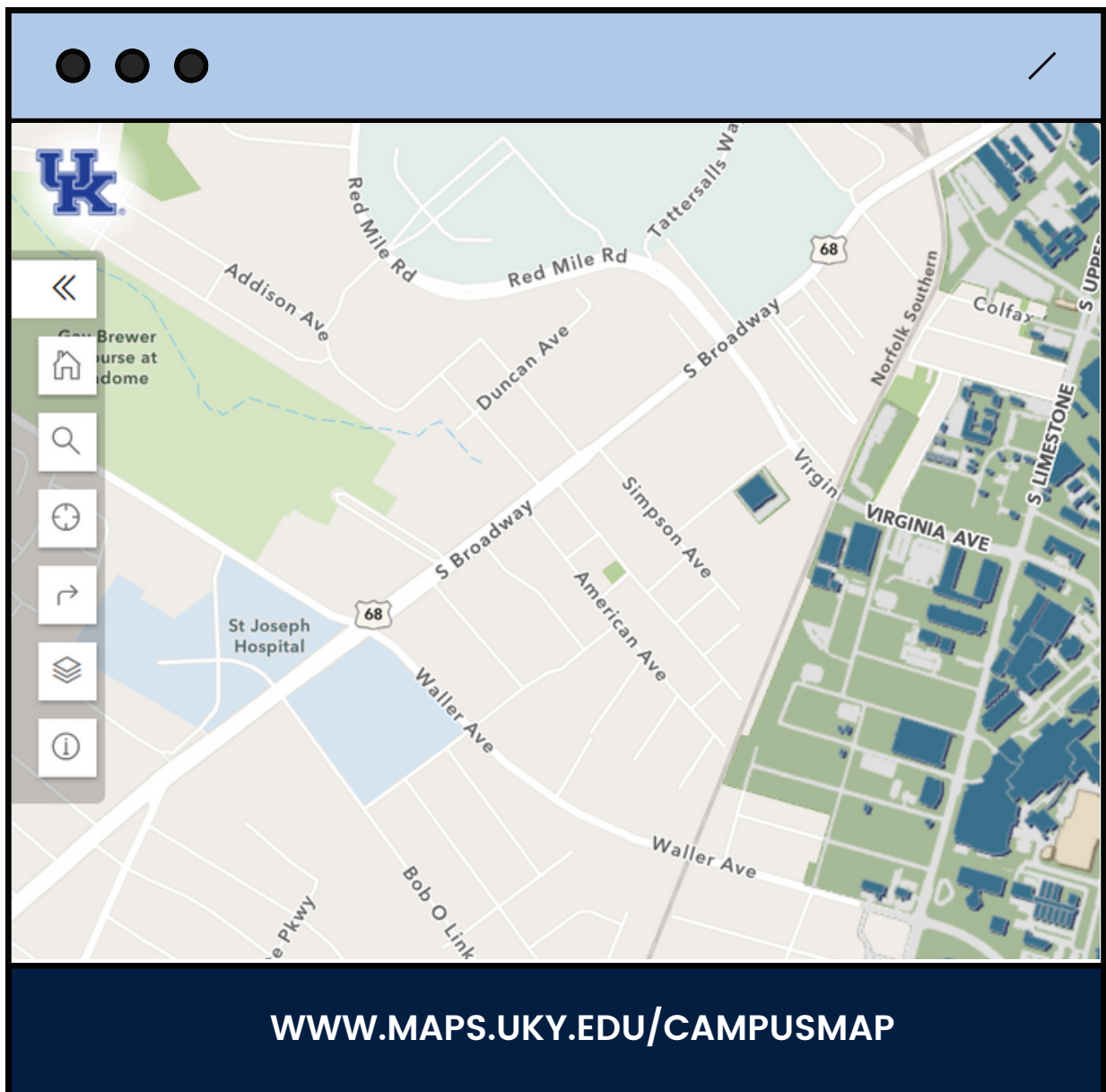

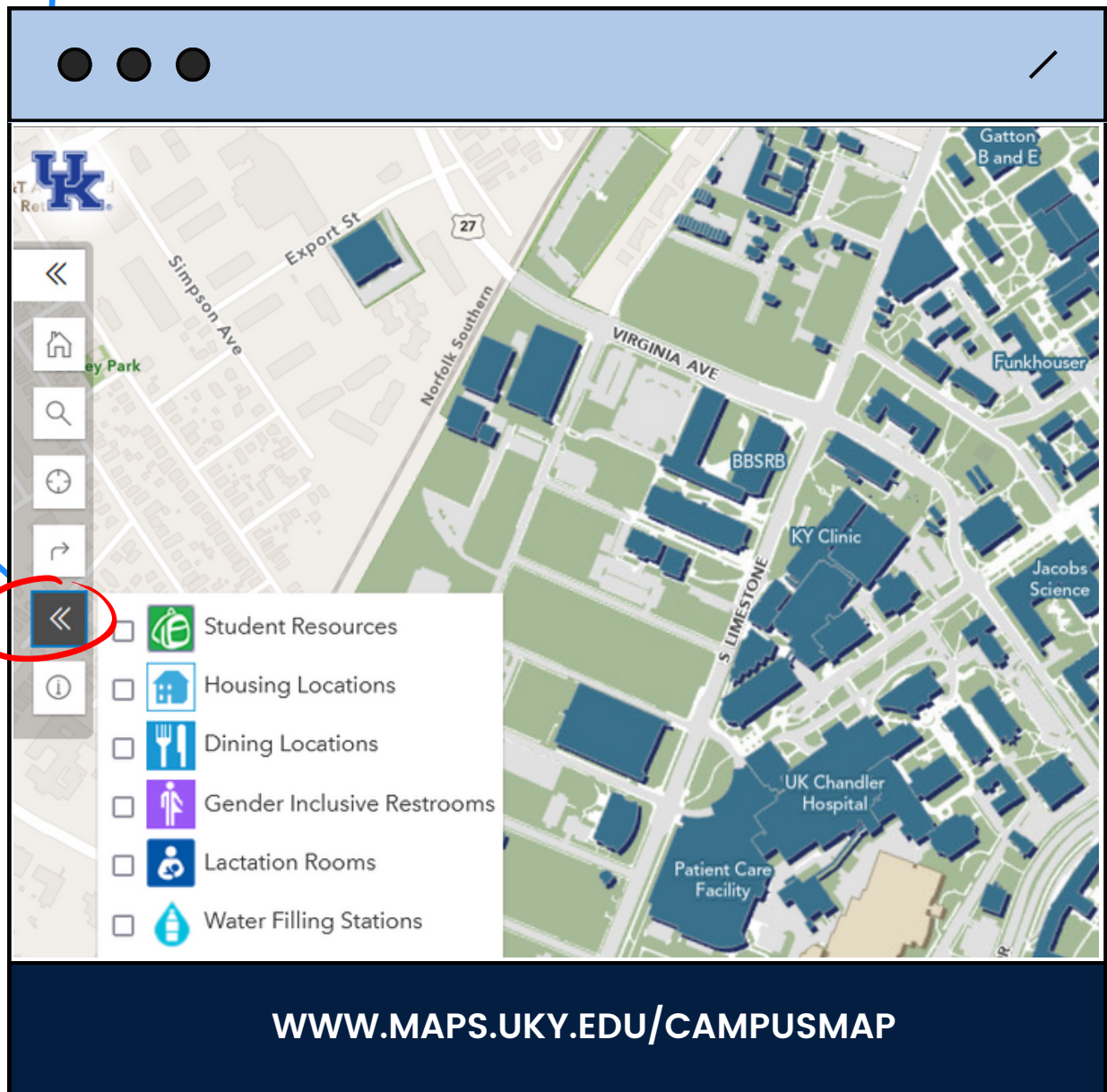
Step 1

www.maps.uky.edu/campusmap




Step 2

Enable the "ADA Information" feature

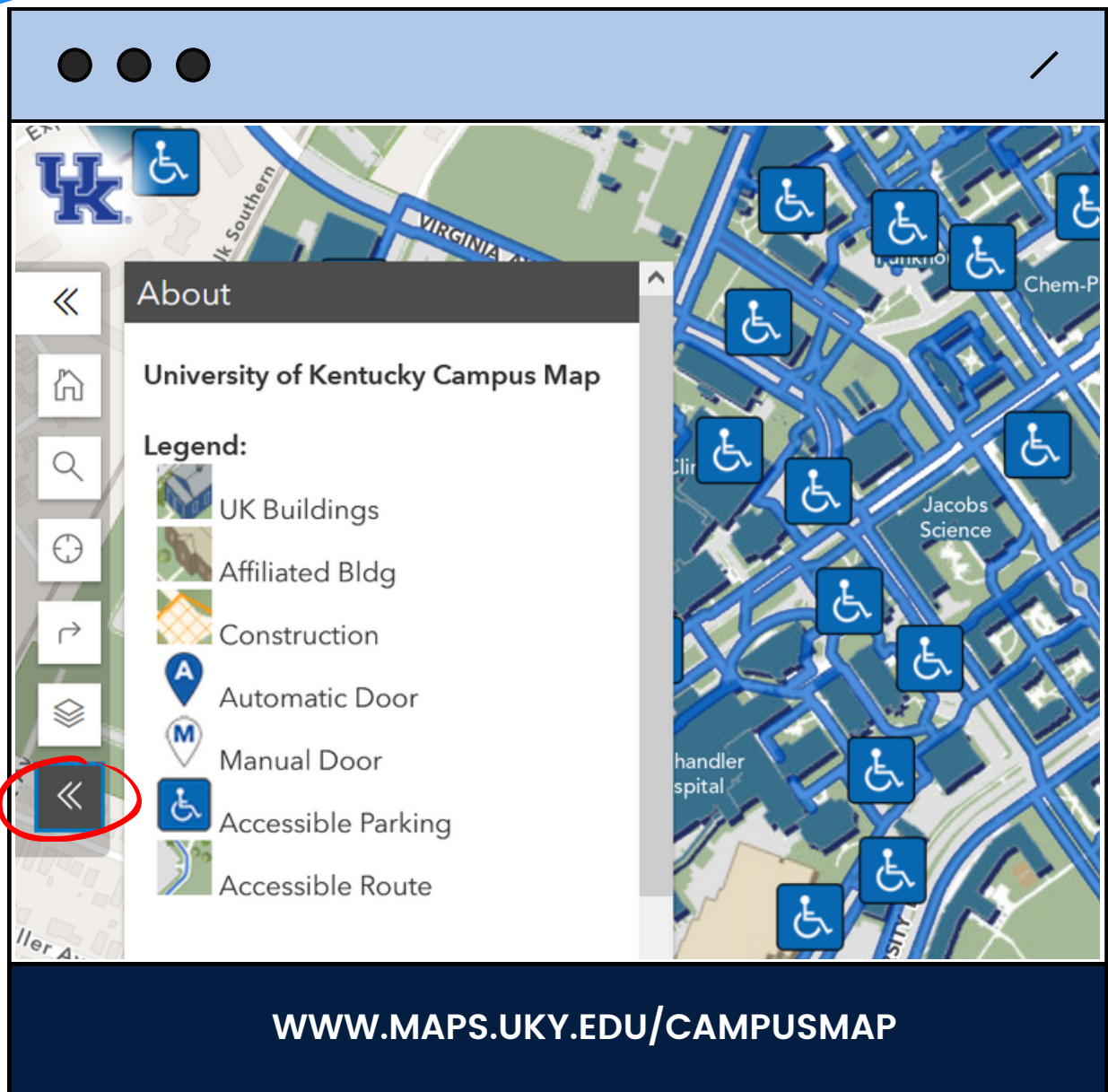

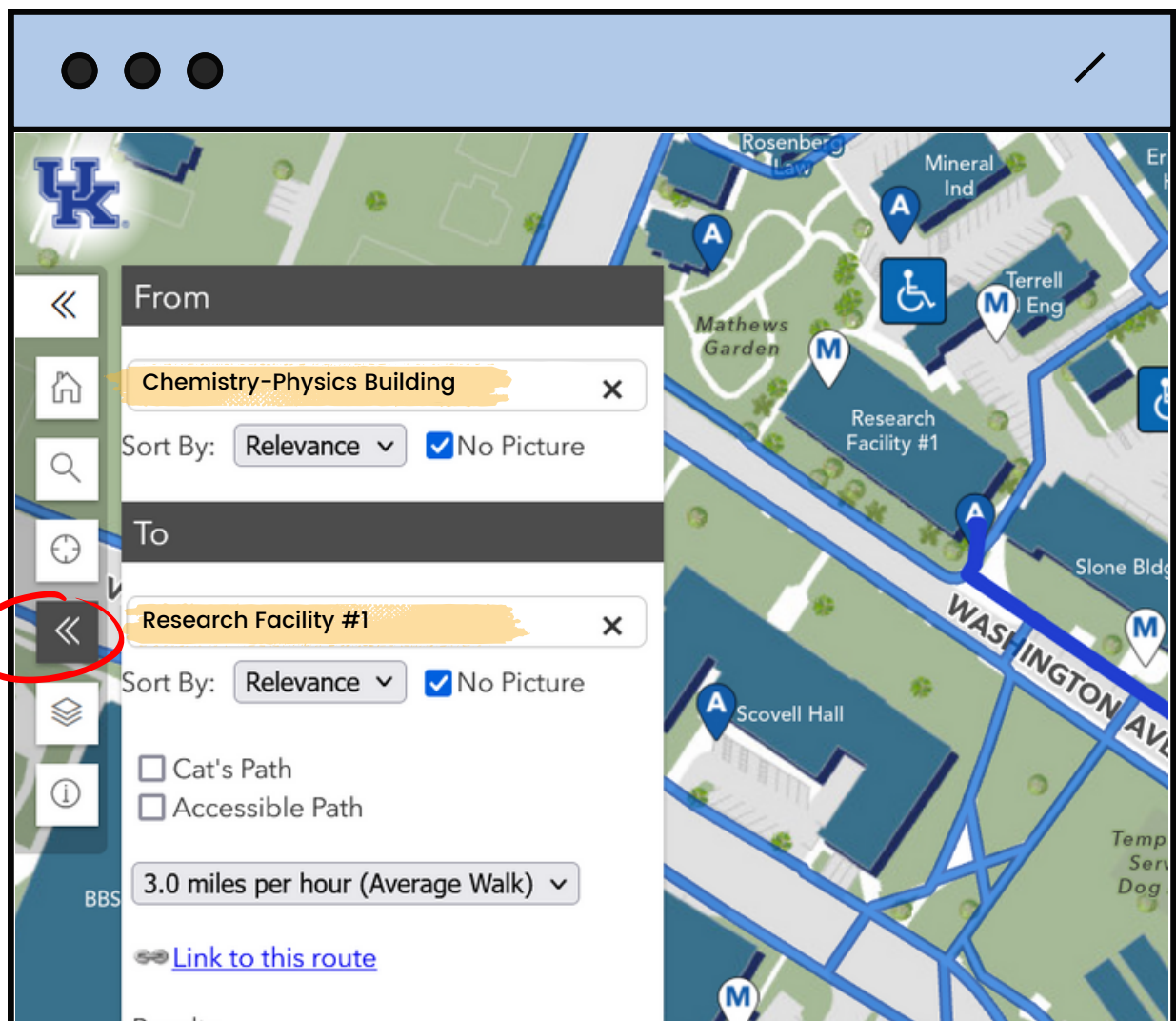
Step 4

Step 5

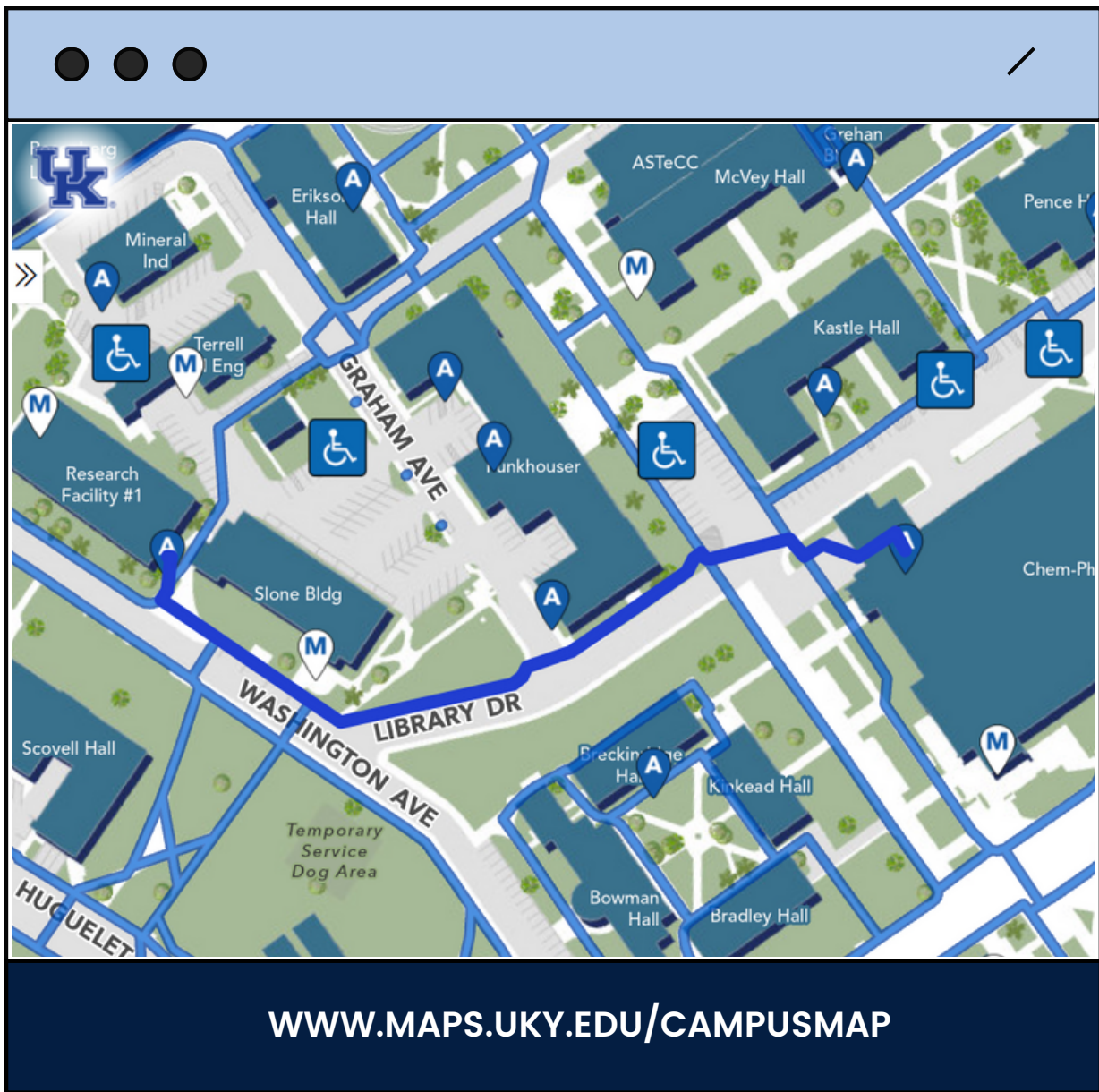
**Select the "Find a Route"

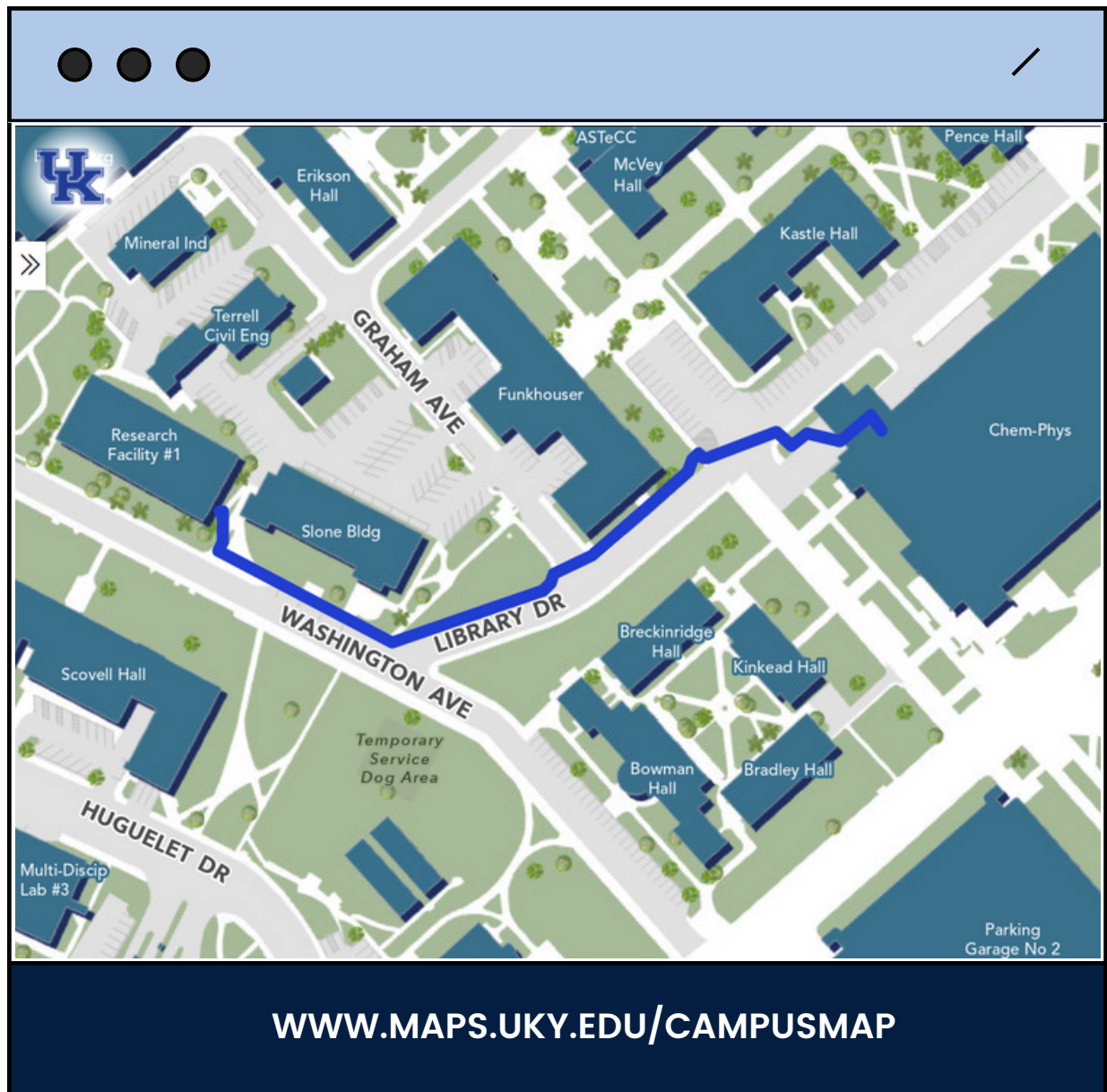
Step 6
